WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT (WIA) REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Workforce Board of Central Florida, d/b/a Workforce Central Florida, is soliciting proposals from qualified organizations for the operation of federally funded Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Title I Youth employment and training programs for the period October 1, 2013, through October 1, 2014, in the following 5 counties: Lake, Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Sumter.

The Workforce Central Florida Youth Committee wishes to solicit proposals from qualified agencies who can deliver a comprehensive youth training program that focuses on work preparation, soft skills training, post-secondary exploration, and tutoring and GED preparation with enhanced case management, counseling and mentoring.

Interested agencies, organizations and other entities are invited to submit a proposal.
