**CAREERSOURCE CENTRAL FLORIDA BOARD OF DIRECTORS & CONSORTIUM**  
**APPROVE FY 2014-2015 BUDGET, PRESENT AWARDS**

*Orlando, FL* – The CareerSource Central Florida Board of Directors and Consortium unanimously approved an approximately \$33.5 million budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 at their second joint meeting of the year this afternoon. The budget was approved unanimously and will take effect July 1.

“This budget represents incredible fiscal responsibility and efficiency,” said CareerSource Central Florida President and CEO Pamela Nabors. “And because of that, we’ll continue to be able to provide the businesses and job seekers within our five-county region the services and programs they need to connect with one another.”

The meeting was also an opportunity to recognize efforts in and around our community over the past several months. Orange County Public Libraries and CareerSource Central Florida were the proud winners of the Libraries Mean Business Award at the Florida Library Association’s Annual Meeting on May 7, 2014.
