## **CENTRAL FLORIDA'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE** **WAS 5.6 PERCENT FOR JANUARY 2015**

- Orlando, FL* – The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Central Florida region (Lake, Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Sumter counties) was 5.6 percent in January 2015. The region's jobless rate was 0.8 percentage point lower than the year ago rate of 6.4 percent and was 0.2 percentage point lower than the state rate of 5.8 percent. Out of a labor force of 1,232,601, there were 69,454 unemployed residents in the region.
- The unemployment rates in the CareerSource Central Florida region were: 6.0 percent in Lake County, 5.5 percent in Orange County, 6.2 percent in Osceola County, 5.3 percent in Seminole County, and 7.7 percent in Sumter.
  - Nonagricultural employment in the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford metro area (Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties) was 1,125,400 in January 2015, an increase of 4.0 percent from a year ago. Statewide, employment was up 3.7 percent from January 2014 to January 2015.
  - The metro area gained 42,900 jobs over the year with most major industries gaining jobs. Leisure and hospitality (+13,100 jobs) gained the most, followed by professional and business services (+9,900 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (+6,600 jobs); education and health services (+5,600 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (+4,300 jobs); financial activities (+2,500 jobs); other services (+600 jobs); manufacturing (+400 jobs); and information (+200 jobs).
  - Government (-300 jobs) was the only industry that lost jobs over the year.
  - The metro area's over-the-year growth rates in leisure and hospitality (+6.0 percent); professional and business services (+5.5 percent); financial activities (+3.6 percent); and manufacturing (+1.0 percent) were stronger than the statewide growth rates in these industries. Information was up in the area but lost jobs statewide.
  - In January 2015, the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford metro area, tied with Miami-Miami-Beach-Kendall, led all metro areas in Florida in over-the-year gains in total nonagricultural jobs. The metro area also led the state in over-the-year gains in leisure and hospitality and professional and business services
  - Nonagricultural employment in The Villages metro area (Sumter County) was 26,000 in January 2015, up 900 jobs, or 3.6 percent since January 2014.
