5	Information and Discussion Review Facility Lease Schedule Reviewed lease schedule of all CSCF locations (attachment). Lease Updates Reviewed below lease updates (attachments): Administration Reviewed proposed office space reduction and lease terms at current location. Broker attained market data from 14 office locations within 1 mile radius of current Admin office; rental rates ranged between \$29 to \$38 per sq. ft. Once lease renewal is finalized at current location, it should remain about \$30 per sq. ft. Seminole State College Reviewed 500 sq. ft. space CSCF to utilize located within Seminole State College/Sanford location – expected launch date 4/1/25. Also includes large space area that can be reserved for events – i.e. job fairs. Valencia College Reviewed 750 sq. ft. space CSCF to utilize located within Valencia College East Campus – expected launch date 4/1/25.

	Ms. Nabors, CEO, relayed about 70% of individuals visiting the career centers come as a requirement of reemployment or cash assistance benefits. To strategically reach those specifically seeking career support and upskilling, CSCF will continue to search for organizations, like colleges, that attract career seekers; where CSCF can co-locate to provide career support. This will also help to provide CSCF provide more flexibility, especially if there is a reduction in funds, as well as reduce brick & mortar costs.
