



Central Florida's Road to Recovery



The Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) released the state's unemployment figures for the month of July. The state's unemployment rate was at 11.3%, up 1.0 percentage point compare to June 2020. The unemployment rate for CSCF's region was 15.1% in July 2020, which was higher than the state's rate of 11.3%. This rate was 11.8 percentage point higher than the region's rate of 3.3% during the same timeframe last year. The labor force was 1,384,716 down 21,624 (-1.5) over the year and there were 209,720 unemployed residents in the region.
