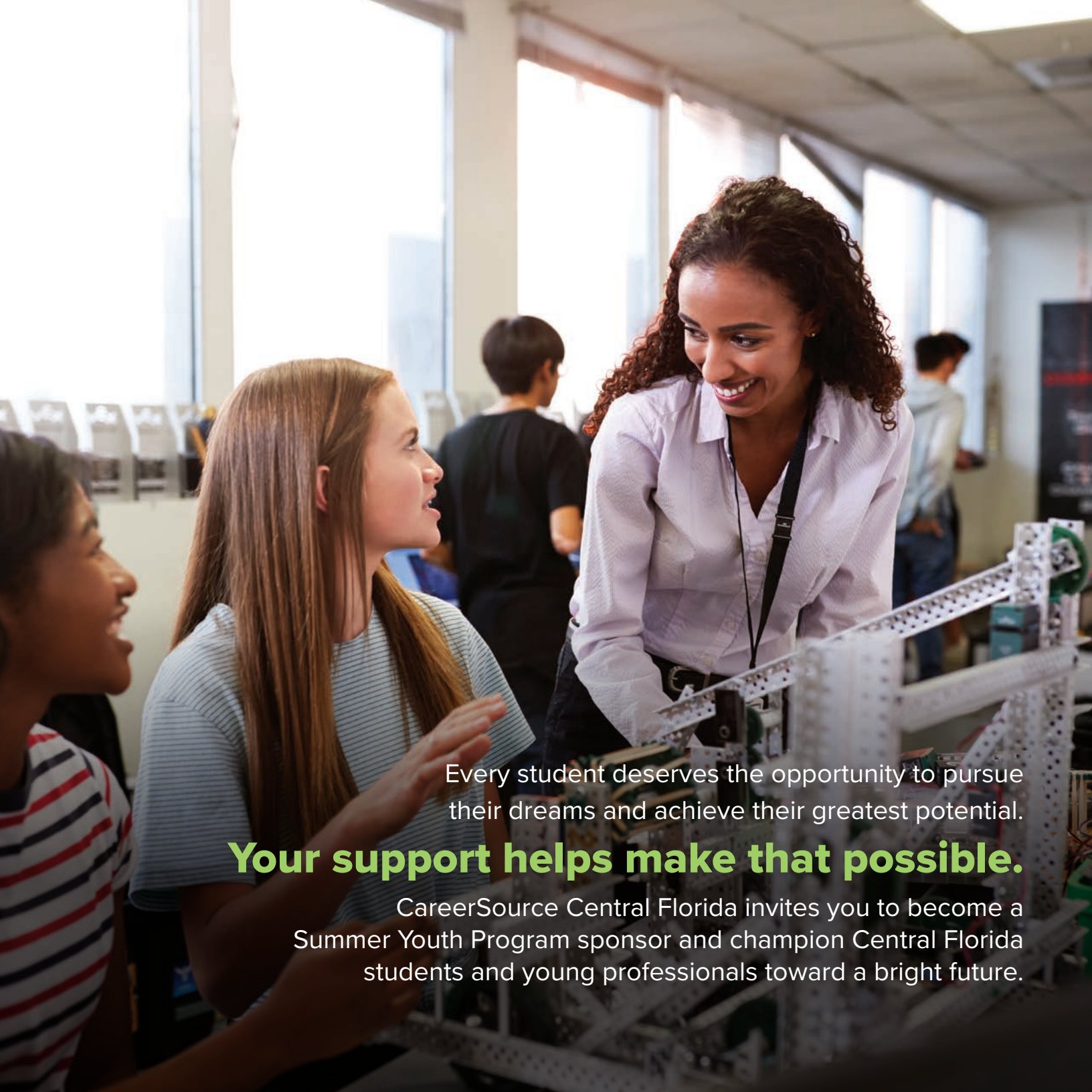

CSCF Summer Youth Program

CSCF's Summer Youth Program offers three college and career readiness programs, designed for students and young professionals ages 16-19 who are beginning their college and career journey. Each program features exclusive access to industry training, professional internships, campus tours, and other helpful resources, to ensure that no student has to make their journey alone.



Deciding which college to attend can be an overwhelming experience for many students. CSCF is partnering with local colleges and universities to help prospective students explore their options and make an informed choice. The Summer Youth Explore program is an opportunity for students to tour local college campuses and explore career options in their field of interest.

Campus Tours, Classroom Learning and Hands-On Projects

- Duration: 4-5 weeks
- Earn incentives
- Tour campuses of participating Central Florida colleges, technical colleges, or universities
- Gain exposure to multiple career options through classroom learning and hands-on projects



CSCF's Summer Youth Experience program gives students paid internship opportunities in their field of interest while gaining hands-on experience. CSCF partners with local businesses to offer professional internships under the guidance and instruction of their seasoned professionals. Businesses gain summer employment at no cost and the chance to share their knowledge and expertise with their future workforce.

Paid Internships Working 30 Hours Per Week
