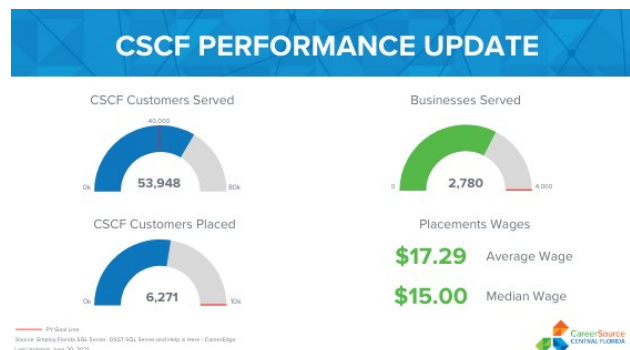

NARCAN[®] Training Begins Next Month at Career Centers



Drug overdoses reached an all-time high in 2020, with the CDC reporting more than 93,000 deaths. As part of CSCF's FORTE initiative ("Fostering Opioid Recovery through Training and Employment"), Human Resources teams can learn about the overdose crisis and how they can identify and support employees who may be impacted. Beginning in August, complimentary training will be offered at CSCF Career Centers on how to administer the life-saving nasal spray naloxone or NARCAN[®]. In addition to the training, participants will be provided two free NARCAN kits.
