Central Florida's Unemployment Rate at 2.7% for October 2018

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Central Florida region (Lake, Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Sumter counties) was 2.7 percent in October 2018. This rate was 0.8 percentage point lower than the region's year ago rate of 3.5 percent. The region's October 2018 unemployment rate was 0.3 percentage point lower than the state rate of 3.0 percent.
