IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TIME ENTRY: To enter time worked, log into: <u>https://www.mypeoplenet.com/</u> (Peoplenet is now called Bullhorn Time & Expense).

- Time must be entered by SUNDAY @ MIDNIGHT to avoid delay in pay.
- Lunch breaks are unpaid and must be recorded under "Breaks" when entering your time.
- Please keep a record of your hours worked to ensure that you do not work more than 40 hours. Overtime will not be allowed.

ATTENDANCE: If you are going to be late or absent, please make sure to contact Manpower & the Manager at your intern site. Attendance is closely monitored, and absences/voluntary time off will not extend the predetermined end date of your internship.

PAYDAY: Every Friday, starting with the second week of work.

SAFETY & HEALTH: Make sure to follow all safety and health guidelines at your intern site. Wash your hands regularly and stay home if you are sick. If you are exhibiting symptoms or have been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, please stay home and contact Zeny or Becky right away.
